WLU Housing FAQ's

Can an incoming freshman choose a roommate?

Yes. You can indicate a roommate preference on your housing/dining services application. Both you and your potential roommate must indicate on each application that you want to live together. We will do our best to accommodate any roommate requests; however, we cannot guarantee that we will always be able to do so.

Can incoming freshmen select their residence hall?

Incoming freshmen can indicate the type of housing they prefer, for example, a double room, a medical single (with doctor's documentation) and the building. The WLU Housing staff will do their best to accommodate any preferences you may have.

When do freshmen receive their housing assignments?

We generally mail a series of information packets that serve as a "notice of assignment" to students, starting early June. This notice will include information on your new assignment and room number, as well as contact information for your roommate(s).

Can I change my room selection?

If you would like to change your room assignment prior to moving into your housing accommodation, contact the WLU Housing Staff. Room changes will be made on a first-requested basis and completed pending space availability. Once moved into your assigned accommodation, you still have the option to move rooms if conflicts arise! If you live in a residence hall and are having an issue with your roommate, contact your resident assistant to discuss the problem.

Can I bring a car to school?

Yes, all students are permitted to have a vehicle on campus. Stop by the WLU Student Affairs Office to pick up your parking pass today! Please note that all students are charged with a parking fee. If you do not bring a car, please notify the Student Affairs office to have the fee refunded.
